AWARDS

Valedictorian

Father Henri Nouwen Award

(formerly Christian Fellowship Award)

This award is given to a student who has demonstrated an understanding that each and every one of us is worthy of respect and dignity, regardless of our abilities, our physical appearance or our popularity. He or she has reached out to others with kindness and understanding.

Male and Female Athletic Awards

These awards are given to a boy and a girl who have consistently displayed excellent athletic skills and sportsmanship. These students are positive role models and successful athletes. They represent the school on various athletic teams, show leadership skills during games, assist peers with game skills, listen attentively and understand the importance of teamwork.

Oral Communications Award

This award is given to a student who expresses himself or herself in a clear and confident manner, who confidently addresses groups when called upon to do so and who captures the attention of his peers and teachers in a positive way.

Overall Academic Achievement

This award is given to the student who has excelled academically in all areas of the curriculum and who consistently completes homework and projects on time and with care.

St. Jude Award

This award is given to a student who, over the course of the Grade 8 year, has made dramatic gains academically. He or she has accepted constructive criticism and has made a conscious and sustained effort to excel.

This award is presented to a student who has been a role model for his or her peers. He or she has shown a great capacity to understand and to forgive.

St. Teresa of Lisieux Award

This award is given to a student who is always ready and willing to assist around the school in practical ways. This student quietly but effectively “gets the job done”.
